



2019 Town of Westport Road Improvements **Reynolds Avenue Reconstruction**

The Town of Westport will soon begin the reconstruction of **Reynolds Avenue**. The project has been publicly bid and the Town Board has awarded the project to Raymond P. Cattell, Inc., from Madison, Wisconsin. They will have various local subcontractors working with them throughout the project.

This newsletter contains some important information concerning the upcoming project and we encourage everyone to review it and keep it on hand to help answer questions you may have.

The Reynolds Avenue Reconstruction Project will consist primarily of the following:

- Remove the existing asphalt and rebuild the road base (north half only)
- Install Geogrid Subbase Reinforcement (north half only)
- Install a new asphalt pavement surface
- Mill the existing asphalt pavement and resurface (south half only)
- Restore the disturbed area with grass seed, fertilizer, and mulch
- Remove & reset existing mailboxes (install a temporary mailbox station)

Reynolds Avenue will remain open to vehicular travel throughout the project. However, drivers may encounter lane restrictions and possible minor delays during the construction. The Contractor will make every effort to provide limited access to private driveways for residential driveways during the project and at the end of each day. The contractor will begin on the far end and will work their way out toward the entrance. Each house on the northerly half will have restrictions to their house during the day as the contractor is working near your home. This restriction will be about 300 feet long (6 houses) that will shift daily toward the roadway entrance each day. However, there may be short periods of time when vehicle access to your property may not be possible. You are encouraged to temporarily relocate any special vehicles such as boats, trailers, RVs, etc., before the construction project begins.

Some of the existing mailboxes will be removed to accommodate the work, and a temporary mailbox station will be installed on Reynolds Avenue near the start of the project. Regular U.S. Mail deliveries to the temporary mailbox station will begin when construction starts. Please watch for a posting and updates on the mailbox station. Upon completion of the project, all mailboxes will be reinstalled by the contractors.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

The project is scheduled to begin in the next couple of weeks and we anticipate completion in approximately 8 – 10 weeks, weather permitting. Weekly updates will be posted on the Town of Westport web site...
