

TOWN OF WESTPORT

PLAN COMMISSION - September 9, 2013

The regular monthly meeting of the Plan Commission was called to order at 7:01 p.m. in the Community Meeting Room of the Bernard J. Kennedy Administration Building by Chair Van Dinter. Members present: Bowen, Grosskopf, Manering, Robinson, Ruskin, Trotter, and Van Dinter. Members absent: None. Also attending were: Terry Enge, Ken Sipsma, Bill von Rutenberg, Gary Presentin, and Tom Wilson.

There was no Public Comment on Matters Not on the Agenda. The minutes of the August 12, 2013 regular meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Robinson, second Grosskopf.

Enge reported on the work of the Park Committee. Bowen reported on the work of the Historic Preservation Committee. For the FUDA Planning Report, Wilson advised the Commission of the work of the Madison/Sun Prairie FUDA planning group and the Town Center streetscape study project.

The Initial Consultation, Rezone (Business Use to Multi-Family Residential, 24-36 Units), Presentin, Former White House Property, CTH M, was then held with the potential applicant being told of various issues raised by the members, including concerns by some regarding having only residential use at this location and general issues regarding the site.

Van Dinter and Wilson reported on items before the Waunakee/Westport Joint Planning Committee and Middleton/Westport Joint Zoning Committee.

For Miscellaneous Matters or Forthcoming Events raised, Wilson reported that the Board will be considering at its next regular meeting the Public Works Committee recommendation on the location and other particulars of the proposed new Town public works facility.
