

TOWN OF WESTPORT

Annual Town Budget Hearing and Special Town Meeting
For 2015 Budget
November 11, 2014

A public hearing on the 2015 proposed budget was called to order at 7:02 p.m. in the Community Meeting Room of the Kennedy Administration Building on Tuesday, November 11, 2014, by the Chair, John Van Dinter. Also attending were: Maureen Van Dinter, Ken Sipsma, Bill von Rutenberg, Brad Robinson, Terry Enge, Bob Anderson and Tom Wilson.

The proposed budget was presented, discussed, comments made, and questions answered. The public hearing was closed at 7:15 p.m. after the Chair called for further comments three times without response.

The special Town Meeting was then convened immediately by the Town Chair John Van Dinter.

The minutes of the November 12, 2013 meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Bill von Rutenberg, second Maureen Van Dinter, by a vote of 6-0.

The road and bridge expenditures in the amount of \$755,102.00, as shown in the proposed budget as presented, including the cost of appropriate 2014 carry over projects, and as available to the Town under the current State levy restrictions, were approved on a motion by Ken Sipsma, second Brad Robinson, by a vote of 6-0.

The tax levy of \$1,565,247.00, as shown in the proposed budget as presented, and as available to the Town under the current State levy restrictions, was recommended for approval on a motion by Maureen Van Dinter, second Ken Sipsma, by a vote of 6-0.

Motion to adjourn by Bill von Rutenberg, second Ken Sipsma. Meeting adjourned by a vote of 6-0 at 7:23 p.m.
