

TOWN OF WESTPORT

ANNUAL TOWN MEETING - April 15, 2014

The Town of Westport Annual Meeting was called to order by Town Chair John Van Dinter on Tuesday, April 15, 2014, in the Community Meeting Room of the Kennedy Administration Building, at 7:00 p.m. Also attending were Brad Robinson, Terry Enge, Ken Sipsma, Bill von Rutenberg, Maureen Van Dinter, Patricia Robinson, Kevin Even, and Clerk Tom Wilson.

The minutes of the 2013 Annual Meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Maureen Van Dinter, second Brad Robinson, 8-0.

A written statement of the Town's financial condition for 2013 including revenues, expenditures and current indebtedness, was presented by Tom Wilson as organized by Bob Anderson, in the form of the draft 2013 financial audit, and shows the Town to be in excellent financial health.

For new business, Town Meeting Resolution 14-01 (Authorizing Construction of Maintenance Structure) was approved as presented after a presentation by Wilson and questions were answered on a motion by Ken Sipsma, second Maureen Van Dinter, with Wilson directed to investigate the cost of making the restroom handicap accessible and the number of fire extinguishers, 8-0. Chair Van Dinter thanked those involved in putting together the plan for the structure, especially mentioning the members of the Public Works Committee and Kevin Even.

For other new business, Wilson advised that the concrete concerns around the Kennedy Building raised at last year's annual town meeting will be addressed with the new garage construction; Patricia Robinson requested the Town investigate getting a fire number installed at 5628 Rankin Lane; and, Patricia Robinson raised concerns over no railing on the east side of Woodland Drive at the culverts over Six Mile Creek, on which Wilson was directed to investigate costs by Chair Van Dinter.

Motion to adjourn by Maureen Van Dinter, second Kevin Even, 8-0. The meeting adjourned at 7:30 p.m.
