

TOWN OF WESTPORT

TOWN BOARD - Monday, April 2, 2018

The regular semi-monthly meeting of the Town Board was called to order in the Community Meeting Room of the Bernard J. Kennedy Administration Building at 7:02 p.m. by Chair Grosskopf. Members present: Cuccia, Enge, Grosskopf, Sipsma, and Trotter. Members absent: None. Also Present: Peter Lindblad, and Tom Wilson.

Nobody was present for Public Comment On Matters Not On the Agenda. The minutes of the March 19, 2018 regular meeting were approved as presented on a motion by Trotter, second Cuccia.

For an Engineer Report, Wilson reported that progress is being made on proposed road projects and a capital plan.

The Friends of Schumacher Farm Park, Temporary Class "B"/Class "B" Retailer's License (6/16/18), Schumacher Farm Park (White Barn, Tent and Fenced Area), 5682 STH 19, was approved as presented and as on file with the Clerk on a motion by Trotter, second Sipsma, conditioned on satisfaction of all state and local requirements.

After discussion, Mary Manering and Eileen Bruskevitz were reappointed to three year terms on the Town Plan Commission as recommended by Grosskopf, with Bruskevitz also reappointed to the JPC for that term, on a motion by Sipsma, second Cuccia.

The Audit Committee recommended payment of bills as presented by the Administrator after questions were answered. Grosskopf and Wilson reported on items before the plan commission/committees.

There were no Administrative Matters for review. For Miscellaneous Business or Forthcoming Events raised, Wilson reminded the Board that tomorrow is the Spring General Election, and the Annual Town Meeting will be on Tuesday April 17 at 7:00 p.m.

Current bills were paid as presented by the Administrator and recommended by the Audit Committee after questions were answered on a motion by Sipsma, second Enge.

Wilson as a DOR certified Board of Review trainer then conducted Board of Review Training for the Board members.

Motion to adjourn by Sipsma, second Enge. The meeting adjourned at 8:23 p.m.
