Annual Town Budget Hearing and Special Town Meeting For 2021 Budget November 10, 2020

A public hearing on the 2021 proposed budget was called to order at 7:01 p.m. using video conferencing due to the COVID-19 pandemic via GoToMeeting.com on Tuesday, November 11, 2020, by the Town Chair, Dean Grosskopf. Also attending were: Kevin Even, John Cuccia, Terry Enge, Ken Sipsma, Mark Trotter, Tim Wohlers, Bob Anderson and Tom Wilson (7 Resident Electors present).

The proposed budget was presented, discussed, comments made, and questions answered. The proposed budget is very similar to the final spending by the Town in 2020. The public hearing was closed at 7:06 p.m. after the Chair called for further comments three times without response.

The special Town Meeting was then convened immediately by the Town Chair, Dean Grosskopf.

The minutes of the November 12, 2019 Special Town Meeting on the budget were approved as presented on a motion by Ken Sipsma, second John Cuccia, by a vote of 7-0.

The road and bridge expenditures in the amount of \$2,116,397.00, as shown in the proposed budget as presented, including the cost of appropriate 2020 carry over projects, and as available to the Town under the current State levy restrictions, were approved on a motion by Terry Enge, second Mark Trotter, by a vote of 7-0.

The 2020 budget as summarized and presented by the Administrator and Finance Manager was recommended for approval to the Town Board on a motion by Ken Sipsma, second Mark Trotter, by a vote of 7-0.

The tax levy of \$2,176,999.00 as presented, all as available to the Town under the current State levy restrictions, was recommended for approval on a motion by Mark Trotter, second Terry Enge, by a vote of 7-0.

Motion to adjourn by Ken Sipsma, second John Cuccia. Meeting adjourned by a vote of 7-0 at 7:12 p.m.
